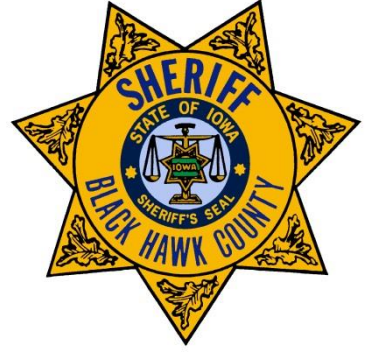

On December 9, 2019 at approximately 12:25pm, Deputies were dispatched to a motor vehicle accident with injuries on I380 at Mile Marker 63. Deputies arrived on scene to what was determined to be a three motor vehicle accident.

A 2018 Crysteel Truck being driven by Kenneth Rembert (age 41) of Waterloo, IA.; was headed northbound on I380 when he lost control on the ice covered roadway. The vehicle crossed the center median into southbound traffic.

The truck driven by Rembert first struck a 2017 Ram Promaster Van being driven by David Dyhuizen (age 58) of Mount Vernon, IA. and then a 2014 Peterbilt Truck being driven by Winston Heck (age 51) of Cedar Rapids, IA.

Rembert and his male passenger were transported from the scene by Gilbertville Ambulance to Mercy 1 with non-life threatening injuries.

The southbound traffic on I380 was shut down and diverted due to this accident and several jack-knifed semi-trucks with trailers in the median between Mile Marker 64 and 62 until almost 2:00pm.

The Black Hawk County Sheriff's Office was assisted by Evansdale PD, ISP, Iowa DOT Vehicle Enforcement, Gilbertville Fire and Ambulance and Sheetz Towing.
