REF: Injury Motor Vehicle Accident I-380 mm 58 Black Hawk County on 10-31-2019

October 31, 2019 0650 a.m. Deputies responded to an injury accident on I-380 southbound at mile marker 58. A northbound vehicle lost control on ice covered roadway and crossed the grass median into the northbound lanes. This required closure of the southbound lanes until 1100 a.m. for rescue efforts and subsequent investigation and scene clean up.

Anna Bindert age 27 of Urbana was transported from the scene by Air Care helicopter to a Waterloo hospital and later in the day transferred to Iowa City hospital with serious injuries. She was driving northbound and crossed the median into the southbound lanes where her car was struck on the driver side by a southbound car.

Maralyn Fagan age 64 of Waterloo was driving south and struck the northbound car in the southbound lanes. Maralyn Fagan and her passenger, William Fagan age 64 also of Waterloo, were transported to a Waterloo hospital by ground ambulances for their non-life threatening injuries.

Agencies assisting at the scene were Iowa State Patrol, Evansdale Police, Gilbertville Fire Rescue, LaPorte City ambulances and fire rescue, Mercy 1 ambulance, and Air Care.
