On October 29, 2019, at approximately 11:50 PM., Black Hawk County Sheriff Deputies responded to the area of Interstate 380 near mile marker 65 on a report of a crash involving two vehicles.

A Lexus sedan was traveling south bound in the north bound lanes when it collided nearly head on with a Nissan pick up truck traveling north bound. The Lexus came to a rest in the west ditch and the Nissan stopped just off the paved shoulder on the east side of the roadway. The driver of the truck sustained non-life threatening injuries and was transported to Mercy One-Waterloo by ambulance. The driver of the Lexus was trapped in the vehicle and had to be extricated by rescue personnel. The driver was initially transported to Mercy One-Waterloo by Air Care and then to University of Iowa Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

North bound traffic on Interstate 380 was diverted to east bound Highway 20 for approximately 3 hours while the crash scene was cleared.

Deputies were assisted on scene by Evansdale Police & Ambulance, Gilbertville Fire and Waterloo Fire. The accident remains under investigation.
