Year 2007 Overview



Population

The 2006 estimated population for Black Hawk County dropped from 128,870 to 126,106. Our county Sheriff's Office is tasked with providing patrol, investigations, jail services and civil process for every citizen of the county. Although the cities of Waterloo, Cedar Falls, Evansdale, Hudson, La Porte City, Dunkerton and Gilbertville each have municipal police offices, the Sheriff's Office continues to provide assistance and resources to every city and citizen as needed.



Every year the consolidated dispatch center sees its annual call volume increase and this year was no different. The 9-1-1 center fielded 133,133 calls for service in 2007. This equates to over one call per citizen of Black Hawk County. The Sheriff's Office accounted for 9,405 of those calls.

2007 Jail Statistics

In 2007, the Black hawk County Jail booked **8,533** inmates. Since 1995, when the new jail was built, we have seen a constant increase in the number of persons processed through our facility. This year was no different, as in 2006, we booked **8,093**.

Jail Statistics Continued:

In the last four years, the jail has also seen steady increase in the amount of time we hold an inmate and the average daily population. To remedy this trend, the Sheriff has focused efforts in an inventive, new approach by partnering with the Department of Corrections, the County Attorney's Office and the First Judicial District's Court Administration to help streamline the judicial process and positively impact the amount of taxpayer's dollars spend on housing inmates. This year our average daily inmate population has benefited from this effort and dropped from 265.7 in 2006 to 243.5 in 2007. Other counties are starting to recognize the success of this program and are beginning to seek assistance from our agency to aid them in similar ventures in their own counties.



In 2007 we are beginning to report and chart processes which were not demonstrated on our previous annual reports. The report will now include Writ of Ejections, Writ of Possession, Writ of Replevins, and Temporary Protective Order Services. The reason for the this improvement is that these services are more laborious and time consuming and address productivity measurements within the division.





Frequency of Calls by Time of Day




Frequency of Calls by Day of the Week






