Year 2005 Overview



Population

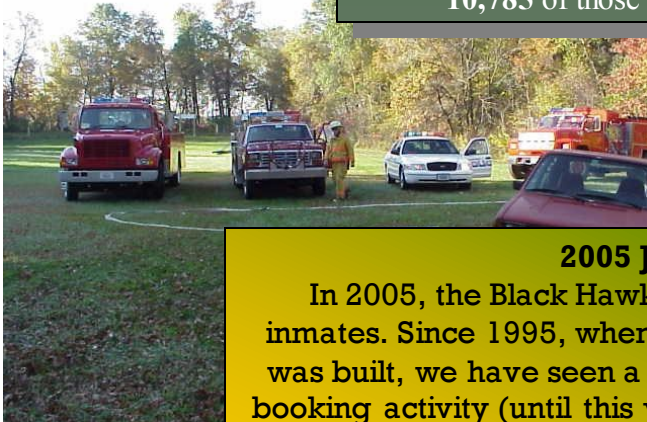
The 2005 estimated population of Black Hawk County is **128,870**. The Black Hawk County Sheriff's Office is tasked with providing patrol, investigations, jail services and civil process for every citizen of the county. And although the cities of Waterloo, Cedar Falls, Evansdale, Hudson, Dunkerton, Gilbertville and La Porte City each have municipal police forces, the Sheriff's Office continues to provide assistance and resources to every city and citizen as needed.



Calls For Service

Every year the consolidated dispatch center sees its annual call volume increase, and this year was no different. The 9-1-1 center fielded **125,660** calls for service in 2005.

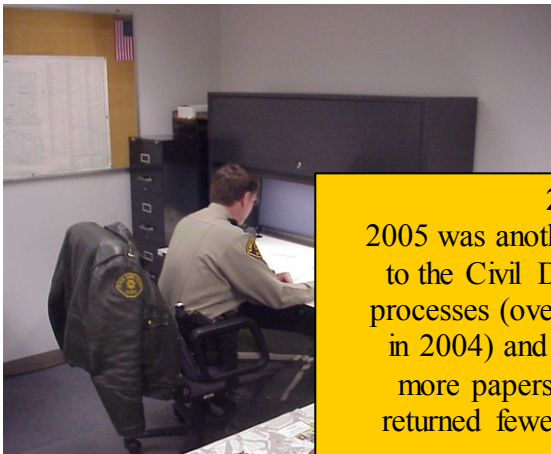
The Black Hawk County Sheriff's Office accounted for **10,785** of those calls.



2005 Jail Activity

In 2005, the Black Hawk County Jail booked in **8,349** inmates. Since 1995, when the new Black Hawk County Jail was built, we have seen a continual increase in our annual booking activity (until this year). In 2004, our jail processed **8,720** inmates, which was the highest recorded book-ins since opening our new facility's doors. We also saw a slight decrease in our average daily inmate population, but a significant rise in our transportation of jail inmates to other facilities.





2005 Civil Processes

2005 was another strong year for officers assigned to the Civil Division. They posted **18,928** total processes (over 1,000 more processes served than in 2004) and **17,042** papers served (over 1,100 more papers served than in 2004). They also returned fewer papers unserved than in previous years.



2005 Warrants

This year saw a dramatic increase in the number of warrants served. In 2004, **908** warrant arrests were made. This year **1,241** warrants were served.

2005 Arrests

Deputies arrested **2,914** persons in 2005. This accounts for 51 more arrests than in 2004.

This year we saw a significant decrease in our motor vehicle accidents and fatalities:

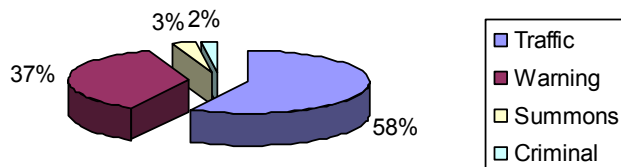

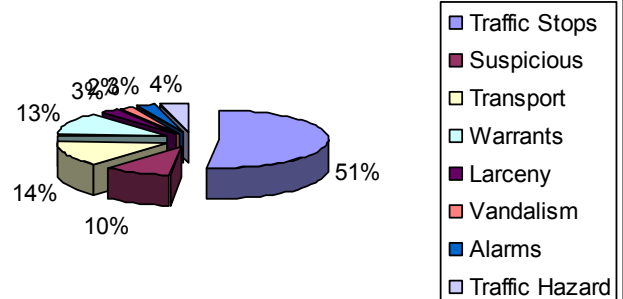

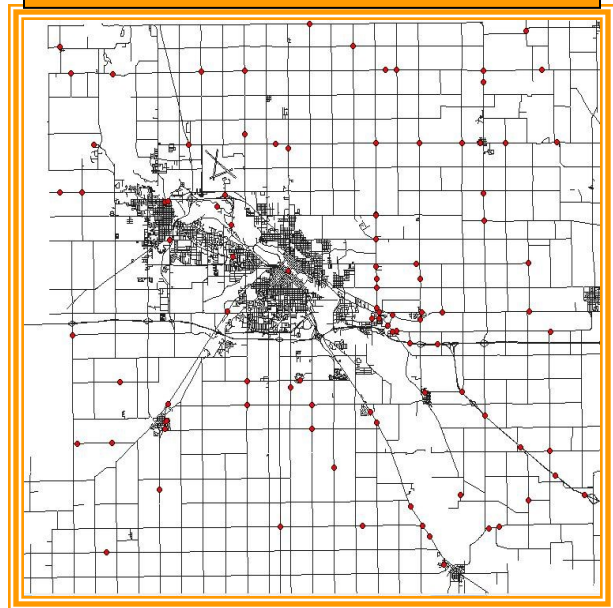






2005 Burglary Pin Map




2005 10-50PD Pin Map
